

The warranty starts from the day we invoice you at the end of the job. The warranty means that we will replace, free of charge, any plant or tree found defective within a year of finishing your project.


Whichever landscaper you choose, make sure they offer a warranty. This gives you peace of mind that you won't be hit with spiraling costs after the project has finished.
